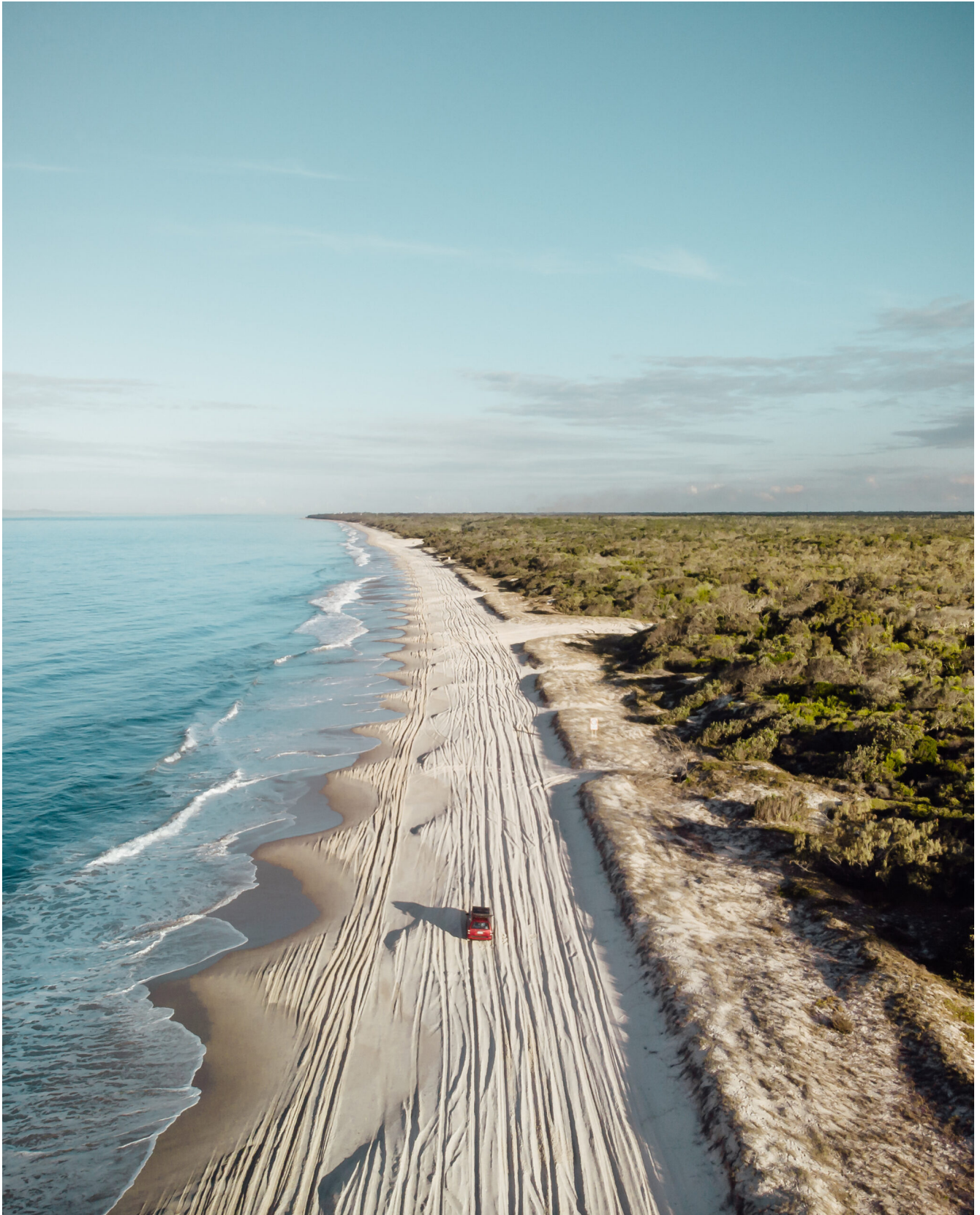

: What to Expect on Your Day Trip



Pick-Up From Brisbane

- Depart **Brisbane at 7 AM or 10 AM** with a friendly guide.
- Travel to Bribie Island in an **air-conditioned 4WD Van**.

2 : Arrival At Bribie Island



- Cross the **Bribie Bridge** and enter a world of stunning beaches and diverse ecosystems.

3 : Off-Road 4WD Adventure



- Get ready for an **exhilarating drive along Bribie Island's coastline**. Feel the thrill as the **4WD vehicle cruises across the sand**, offering breathtaking views of Moreton bay and the **Pacific Ocean** on one side and towering dunes on the other.

Along the way, you'll have **opportunities to spot native wildlife**, including:



Kangaroos grazing on the sand dunes (at times on the beach itself)



Sea eagles soaring overhead



Goannas and other reptiles basking in the sun



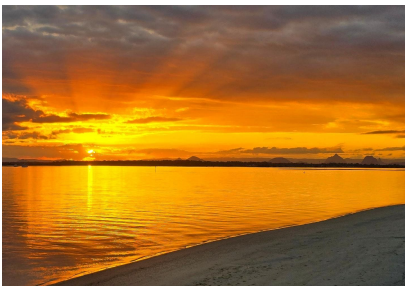
Dolphins playing in the waves (seasonal)

During the right season, you might even **spot Whales breaching** and cruising along the coastline
Or **Baby turtles** making their way off the dunes into the ocean

along **sandy beaches and rugged bush tracks**.

- Explore **remote areas of Bribie Island's National Park**.
- Keep an eye out for **wildlife**—kangaroos, birds, Wallabies, Goannas and more!

4 : Explore The Tea-Tree-Stained Lagoons



One of the most unique sights on Bribie Island is its **tea-tree-stained lagoons**. The deep **amber color** of the water comes from the surrounding tea trees, creating a **serene and picturesque** swimming spot.



Swimming is optional, but highly recommended! For those wanting a bit more adventure, **stand-up paddleboards** are available for shared use, giving you a chance to **glide across the calm waters** while

enjoying the tranquility of the lagoon.

5 : Step Back In Time At Fort Bribie



History lovers will appreciate a visit to **Fort Bribie**, one of the island's **World War II bunkers**. Learn about Bribie Island's **military history** and explore the remains of **gun emplacements and mine control huts**, once used to protect the Australian coastline.

6 : Relax And Swim At Ocean Beach



After or before (depending on tides) the excitement of 4WDing and history exploration, it's time to **unwind on Ocean Beach**. Whether you want to:



Sunbathe on the sand



Swim in the crystal-clear waters



Capture stunning coastal views

7 : Lunch With A View
