1: Kominos Winery

2: Ballandean Estate



On to the oldest winery in the Granite Belt, Ballandean Estate. Established in 1932, five generations of the Puglisi family have made the business what it is today. Our wine tasting will take place in a private room with a selection of seven wines and a cheese board to match. After the tasting, a picnic basket is provided filled with fresh local seasonal produce.

3: Symphony Hills
